Friday and Saturday in Cairns. We hope to hear some great results upon your return. Good luck!

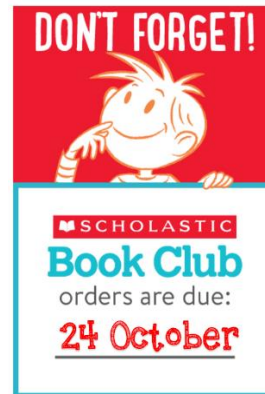
