CASCIA

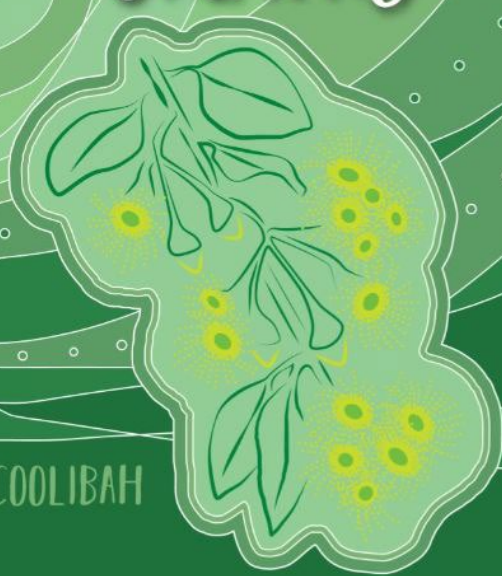


BORONIA

OUR CASCIA MAROON SPORTS HOUSE IS NAMED AFTER ST RITA OF CASCIA. SAINT RITA WAS BORN IN CASCIA, ITALY ABOUT THE YEAR 1320. RITA JOINED THE AUGUSTINIAN CONVENT OF NUNS IN CASCIA AFTER SHE WAS WIDOWED. SHE WAS KNOWN AS A WOMAN OF PRAYER AND A FEARLESS PEACEMAKER.

AFTER HER BELOVED ROSE SEEDS FROM HER HOME TOWN BLOOMED IN WINTER.

FR JOHN O'SULLIVAN AND FR GERRY DULLARD ARRIVED IN THE PARISH IN JAN 1987, THE FIRST MASS WAS CELEBRATED ON SUNDAY, 18TH JAN IN 229 DART ST, REDLAND BAY. FATHER GERARD DULLARD WAS THE FIRST PARISH PRIEST OF ST RITA'S.

OUR PENOLA BLUE HOUSE IS NAMED AFTER THE HOME TOWN OF ST MARY OF THE CROSS MACKILLOP, AUSTRALIA'S FIRST SAINT AND PATRON OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF QUEENSLAND. BORN IN MELBOURNE IN 1842 AND FIRED BY A DEEP DESIRE TO SERVE GOD AND HELP ALLEVIATE THE PLIGHT OF THE POOR, MARY WAS AN ORDINARY PERSON WHO LIVED A HOLY LIFE. HER MOTTO IS
'NEVER SEE A NEED WITHOUT DOING SOMETHING ABOUT IT.'

WE ACKNOWLEDGE THE QUANDAMOOKA PEOPLE, TRADITIONAL CUSTODIANS OF THE LANDS, WATERS AND SEAS WHERE WE STAND TODAY. ABORIGINAL PEOPLE HAVE LIVED ON AND AROUND WHAT IS NOW THE REDLANDS FOR TENS OF THOUSANDS OF YEARS.
